



The EU Battery Regulation Ensuring safety and sustainability





The new Regulation entered into force on 17 August 2023, replacing the Battery Directive 2006/66/EC which will expire two years later with some exemptions. In contrast to a directive, a regulation is a legal act which applies automatically and uniformly in all EU countries, without the need for transposition into national law.




