
CPSC RECALL STATISTICS QUARTER 1, 2018

Summary

The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) is an independent federal regulatory agency tasked with protecting the public from unreasonable risks of injury or death from consumer products through education, safety standards activities, regulation, and enforcement actions.

The Commission uses a wide range of strategies to identify and address product safety hazards that includes product recalls or other corrective/legal actions.

In Quarter 1 2018, the number of product recall for Softlines and Hardlines have decreased as compared to the previous quarter. On the other hand, the recalls for Electrical Products have increased.
